Dear Rowers and Parents,

Here is some information pertaining to our trip to the Stotesbury Cup Regatta in Philadelphia. Our itinerary is as follows:

Thursday, 19 May 2011:

- 8:30 AM Leave from Teaneck High School
Most likely, we will have two vans and the tow-vehicle for the trailer for transportation to Philadelphia.
- 11:00 AM Arrive at the Schuylkill River in Philadelphia and rig the boats
- 1:00 PM Go out for a practice row on the Schuylkill River
- 5:00 PM Check in at the Comfort Inn, Trevoise, PA
- 6:30 PM Go out for dinner in Philadelphia.
- 10:00 PM Lights out and sleeping... we want to be in good shape for racing!

Friday, 20 May 2011:

FIRST RACE DAY

- 7:00 AM Racing begins with Time Trials, and Semi-Finals
Actual race times are not yet available but will be sent out as soon as they are available.
- 6:30 PM Go out for dinner, then drive back to the hotel.

Saturday, 21 May 2011:

SECOND RACE DAY

- 8:00 AM Racing continues with Semi-Finals and Finals
- 6:00 PM Return Trip Home

Hotel Accommodations:

We will stay at the **Comfort Inn** located at 2779 Roosevelt Boulevard (US Route 1 North) in Trevoise, PA 19053 [<http://www.comfortinn.com/hotel-trevoise-pennsylvania-PA366>]
Each room will be \$72.00 — Equal **cost to each person: \$36.00** (4 per room/2 nights)

Cost to Participants:

In order to stay within the THS Crew Team's operating budget for the season we will need to collect a \$20 participation fee from each rower. Please make sure to make your checks payable to "Teaneck Rowing Club," and give your check as soon as possible to Coach Clemens, together with you signed permission slip.

Chaperones:

I am hoping to find about four (4) parents who might volunteer to help chaperone the team. If you are not available for both nights, maybe you can do one of them, and someone else can do the other night. Please let me know if you are available. In order not to lean too hard on the School budget I would like to ask the chaperons to contribute to their hotel cost. You can do that in form of a tax deductible donation to "Teaneck Rowing Club," since TRC will pay the full cost of the hotel first, and will then later be reimbursed by the Teaneck Schools.

Food & Meals:

Please bring sufficient money for meals, or bring your own food. Thursday and Friday evening we will go out to eat together. Plan on bringing about \$50 for meals (\$25 per evening). If you want to buy any souvenirs or rowing items from any of the vendors around the regatta venue I suggest you bring additional funds with you.
